V. Old Business

Our plan is to clean up the property, sometime in March would be a good time to do a clean up to comply with city. We should try and get volunteers who have trucks to help. GM Ortiz and some board members will be meeting with Mr. Reynolds from the City on Tuesday March 1st. It was decided that Bernie Hovden attend this meeting also. GM Ortiz and President Sanchez will make appointments and meet with individual city council members about Finley property. Director Lopez will contact city council members as soon as possible to set up meetings. Director Lopez made the motion to pay the \$510.00 to file the appeal to city to buy us some time, 2nd by Director Morales, approved.

We would like \$7,000 to go toward website, and \$3,000 for a development consultant from Wells Fargo Facility Capability Proposal.
